### AIM OF THE GAME

- Make sure you have space to play on (about 10 cards wide and 10 cards tall).
- Pick two Frozen characters!  
**For four players: Pick one character or play in teams of two.**
- Shuffle the Start cards, pick one and place it face up in the middle.

## HOW TO PLAY

The player with the coldest hands starts.

### On Your Turn

- Take the top card from your pile. Try to create whole snow crystals that match the one shown on your character card(s), making sure that whenever you place a card, any sides that are touching match each other.

**Remember:** each card is double-sided, so you have lots of possibilities!

- If you can't match any snow crystals that belong to your own characters, match them for other characters! The player who has that character must say thank you.

- If there are characters not in the game you can still make snow crystals for them, but no player collects points for them at the end of the game.
- If any of the half snow crystals on your card match anywhere on the grid, you must play the card. Even if it means making snow crystals for everyone except you!
- If everyone agrees that there's nowhere your card can go, put it out of the game.
- Time for the next player to take a turn.

**Every complete snow crystal is worth 1 point at the end of the game, or more if the Snowgie is on your snow crystal! (see "How to Score")**

### Things To Remember

- All snow crystal cards played must match on all sides.
- Always say **Thank you** when someone matches a snow crystal for you!



### THE WINNER!

**If you have the most complete snow crystals that match your character(s), you're the winner!** (see how to score below).

**Congratulations!**  
**Want to keep playing? Play another two games. The person who wins the most games is the Frozen heroine!**

### EXAMPLE GAME PLAY

**Laura** has chosen Elsa and Olaf. That means she is collecting Blue and Yellow snow crystals.

She picks up the next card and looks at the cards already played. The illustration shows the three possible places she can play the card.

If she played it in **location 1** she would also be next to the Snowgie. That means at the end of the game that card would score 2 points.




Once all the cards are played, all players take turns to add up their snow crystals. It is easier to do this by counting in rows or columns one at a time (*as shown opposite*).

**Remember:** Each complete snow crystal that matches the snow crystal of your characters is worth 1 point. If the Snowgie is on any part of the snow crystal it scores 2 points.

**If the Snowgie is on BOTH cards then you score 4 points!**

Add up your scores. (It might be helpful to use paper and pencil to keep score.)
