

Game Rules

Crazy Eights

Object of the game: To be the first to get rid of all your cards. How to get started: Shuffle the cards and deal out 5 to each player. Put the remaining cards in a pile, face down. This is the draw pile. Turn the top card face up and place it next to this pile. This is the first card in the discard pile. Choose a player to begin. Players take turns in a clockwise direction.

The game: The player whose turn it is can lay down a card that matches the colour, number or symbol of the uppermost card on top of the discard pile. If he or she plays a card with an action symbol, then the corresponding action must be carried out.

Play then moves to the next player. If he or she cannot play a card, then he or she must draw a card from the draw pile. If he or she can play this card, then he or she can do it right away. If not, play moves to the next player.

The winner: The game continues this way until there is a player with only one card in his or her hand that he or she can also get rid of. When getting rid of his or her next-to-last card, the

player must have called "Shuffle" very loudly. It's only after this and after getting rid of the last card that the player wins the game! If he or she forgets to do this and the other players notice, then he or she has to draw two cards from the stack and the game continues.

Action Cards



If you play this card, the next player loses a turn.



If you play this card, the game changes direction.



If you play this card, the next player has to draw two extra cards.



If you play this card, you can choose a different colour which changes the colour for all other players of the game.
